The Treasurer will also require your ball order form to be returned at the AGM.** Administration by some Clubs was particularly bad this year, and this caused problems for both the Secretary and the Management Committee.

Now is the time for your Club to put forward proposals for the AGM. All those details that you consider would make the League better. Please send them to the Secretary, seconded by another Mid Bucks Club, to arrive here before October 20<sup>th</sup>. The League also needs more helpers. This Year we only had nine Committee members, in spite of repeated requests for more. More helpers not only make life easier, but they also make the whole system run more smoothly, and they show that your Club actually has an interest in the League.
